Course Description:

This course provides an orientation to the health care cluster consisting of the five areas: Therapeutic Services, Diagnostic Services, Supportive Services, Information and Communication Services, and Biotechnology and Pharmaceutical Services. This course is designed to develop and enhance an understanding of the roles and responsibilities of each career major. Communication, Collaboration, Critical Thinking, and Creativity will be emphasized as the student learns about the health care industry and career opportunities available. Upon successful completion of this course, the student will be able to focus on a career path and make informed choices for continuing education or work experience.

Classroom Goals:

By the end of this course, the student will:

- Focus on a career path and make informed choices for continuing education
- Explore and evaluate the changes in healthcare delivery systems.
- Identify the impact of religions and cultures on healthcare systems.
- Explore life changes as they relate to healthcare.
- Understand the ethical and legal responsibilities of a healthcare provider.
- Be introduced to medical terminology and abbreviations.
- Learn concepts related to microbiology, anatomy and physiology, and adult basic life support.

- Maintain a neat and organized notebook.
- All school rules apply in the classroom.
